Trident Blue is an easy-care ground cover with powdery blue-grey leaves that display an intriguing shape. Bred by Attila Kapitany for Australian conditions, Trident Blue is easy to grow, has low water needs and very low maintenance requirements.

Trident Blue's thick, elongated leaves have a glaucous, powdery finish and come to a point in a fascinating lance-like shape, similar to the mythical Greek God Poseidon's trident.

With chalky blue tridents that retain their colour all year round, Trident Blue is set apart from similar varieties and is an absolute stand out. Spreading up to 1 meter-wide, Trident Blue is well suited for mass plantings or as a feature plant among other bold colours to really show off the foliage form and colour.

- Blue/grey leaves with a powdery finish
 - Interesting lance-like shape
 - Tall, slender, pale yellow flowers in warmer months.
 - Thick ground cover that acts as a good weed suppressant

COMMON NAME	Blue chalk sticks
PRODUCED FROM	Cuttings
KEY NOTES/ATTRIBUTES	Beautiful blue, typical of <i>Kleinia</i> varieties, but with interesting foliage forming a trident
HEIGHT	30cm
WIDTH	to 1m
HABIT	Low growing ground cover
MAINTENANCE	Remove spent flower heads, prune as desired to maintain shape. Use free draining potting mix
SEASONAL CLIMATE ZONE	Most regions of Australia
RECOMMENDED POT/PLUG RATIO	1 plug per 140mm pot
FLOWERING PERIOD	Throughout spring and summer
GROWING MEDIA PH RANGE	pH 6.0-6.5
WATERING	Allow to dry out somewhat between watering. Do not overwater.
FERTILISER	Controlled release general purpose fertiliser is suitable
PESTS & DISEASES	Very few pests or diseases bother Trident Blue.
FINISHING TIMES	In 140mm pot, 12-14 weeks
LIGHT REQUIREMENT	Full Sun
