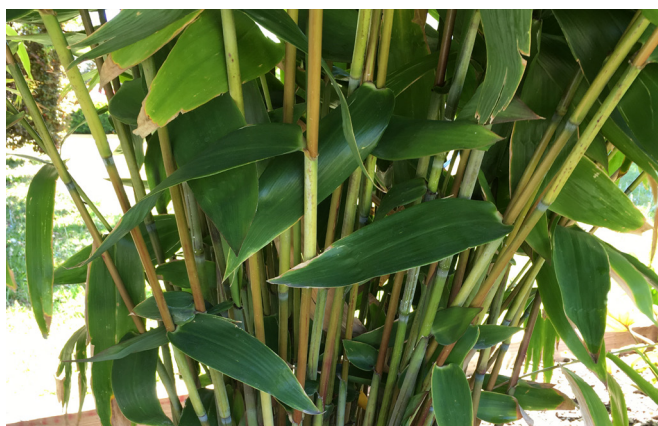




# TIGER GRASS



## THYSANOLAENA TIGER GRASS

This striking plant from Thailand has the appearance of tropical bamboo but is actually a perennial grass. This results in a stunning exotic display without the risk of the roots invading neighbouring plants. Tiger Grass is fast growing and works great as a privacy or wind screen due to its thick clump forming habit.

This plant is the perfect bamboo alternative, with long, lance shaped leaves that run the length of its slender stems. Growing typically to around 2m in height, Tiger Grass display well blended in a garden or mass planted with other tropical plants. They can also be planted in large pots or containers for a more portable screen
