## STRAPPY LEAF PLANTS

### A beautiful, compact, and disease-resistant plant with deep-green evergreen foliage.

- Female sterile plant, making it less attractive to ants, adding to its already high Phytophthora resistance.
- Clean, cascading, green leaves with self-cleaning flowers, making it an elegant plant choice.
- 30% shorter and wider spread than the original Tanika® *Lomandra*, making it perfect for line-of-site landscapes and weed control.
- Tough and forgiving plant that can survive poor conditions, making it ideal for low-maintenance and versatile landscape use.

| <b>Care</b>               | Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; requires less frequent pruning and has shown to reshoot far better, more consistently, and faster than most other <i>Lomandra</i> types                       |
